

- ✓ The family <u>area attractions</u> include the San Antonio Zoo, the GO RIO cruises, the SEA LIFE Aquarium, the Six Flags Fiesta Texas, the Witte Museum of science, history, and culture all things Texas, the Tower of the Americas, LEGOLAND Discovery Center.
- ✓ The hotel is a 5-minutes' walk from the <u>Alamo</u>, the most famous historical site in Texas. Founded in 1718 as the first mission in San Antonio, the Alamo served as a way station between East Texas and Mexico. In 1836, during the war with Mexico, 189 Texas rebellions fought (and were killed) in this little fortress - resisting for 13 days the numerous soldiers of the Mexican general. A month later, the Texas army, led by general Houston, attacked the Mexicans shouting: "Remember the Alamo!" and won the war for independence. A few years afterwards, Texas joined the U.S. confederation.
